INSTRUCTIONS

This notice of Judgment Lien should be filed only if the judgment is a money judgment that was first entered in this State after June 30, 1983 (see Code of Civil Procedure Section 697.510).

- ITEM 1: Enter name of judgment debtor as it appears in the judgment.
- ITEM 1A-1C: Enter last-known mailing address of the judgment debtor.
- ITEM 2: Enter name of additional judgment debtor, if any. If there is more than one additional judgment debtor, continue item 2 on an additional white sheet of paper 8 1/2x11 in size.
- ITEMS 2A-2C: Enter last-known mailing address for any additional judgment debtor.
- ITEM 3: Enter the name and mailing address of the judgment creditor. The name of the judgment creditor should be as it appears in the judgment.
- ITEMS 4A-4D: Enter information from the judgment.
- ITEM 4F: Enter amount of the judgment adjusted for interest and payments to the date of the notice.
- ITEM 4G: The date of the notice will normally be the date the notice is executed.
- ITEM 5: This notice of judgment lien on personal property must be signed by the judgment creditor's attorney, if the judgment creditor has an attorney of record. If the judgment creditor does not have an attorney of record, then it must be signed by the judgment creditor. (Code of Civil Procedure Section 697.550).
If the individual signing the notice signs on behalf of a law firm, which is the attorney of record, the name of the law firm should be entered BENEATH, not above, the signature. If the signature is for a judgment creditor, which is an entity, the name of the entity should be entered BENEATH, not above, the signature of the person signing for the judgment creditor.
- ITEM 7: If the attorney of judgment creditor wishes an acknowledgment of filing, the original and first copy of the notice of judgment lien must be presented for filing. Indicate in item 6, the name and mailing address of the person who is to receive the acknowledgment of filing.

NOTICES

- FILING PERIOD: A Notice of Judgment Lien on personal property shall not be filed if it is presented for filing more than 10 days after the date of the notice (CCP Section 697.570) Receipted of the notice in the Secretary of State's Office shall be considered the date it is presented for filing. The date the notice is postmarked will not constitute presentation for filing.
- NOTICE: At the time of the filing the Notice of Judgment Lien on personal property or promptly thereafter, the judgment creditor is required to serve a copy of the Notice of Judgment Lien on the judgment debtor (Code of Civil Procedure Section 697.560).
- TERMINATION: In order to terminate the judgment lien on personal property, an Acknowledgment of Satisfaction of Judgment or a court clerk's certificate of satisfaction of judgment will have to be filed with the Secretary of State's Office (Code Civil Procedure Section 724.060(7)).
- FILING FEE: The Notice of Judgment Lien must be submitted with a filing fee of twenty dollars (\$20) payable to the Secretary of State. DOCUMENTS NOT ACCOMPANIED BY THE FILING FEE WILL NOT BE FILED.
