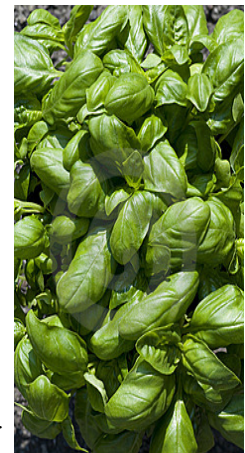
Cadence goes to South America!!

Dining Plus Plan

Any student living off campus (or a resident student wishing to augment his basic Resident Dining Plan) may open a Dining Plus Plan for on campus dining with a deposit of any amount. A Dining Plus Plan remains open throughout enrollment and offers an 9.25%

savings on all food purchases anytime, anywhere on campus! Just think, each time you buy your morning coffee, afternoon snack, evening meal or when you stock up on beverages for the week-end from Cellar Market you can save! Plus, if you use the Dining Rewards Card (available at any register) you get an even better value with your purchase!

Last spring we ran a pilot program introducing the campus to SCU Dining Services' sustainable Eco To Go program. We really appreciated those of you who helped us bring this to campus - thank you all! This year the Eco To Go program is back and we invite you to try it for yourself - whether you live on campus or commute, the Eco Tray is a fantastic 'green' solution for enjoying your meal on the go!



3 simple steps

1. **Enter:** sign up at Market Square with SCU ID and pay refundable deposit. You'll receive a keychain to exchange for your first EcoTray
2. **Exchange:** Give your keychain to the server in exchange your meal presented in an EcoTray when purchased at Market Square
3. **Enjoy:** your meals to go while saving resources - conveniently! When done, simply exchange the used EcoTray at any café on campus during regular hours for a keychain & you're ready to start again.

You may opt out of the program at any time by returning your keychain or EcoTray to Market Square with your SCU ID. Full program information is available in the café, with cashiers or on our website at www.scu.edu/diningservices
