Students will receive the final interview schedule for PI/PS Day.



Formal Interview Application Process


- Apply through [One Justice's Website](#)

Getting to PIPS Day

- Arrive 30-45 mins before your first interview
- If driving, remember the parking garages (either Hastings lot or Civic Center-CC garage don't open until 8am)
- Don't forget to add walking time!
- Leave yourself time to get lost and acquainted with the map. If using public transportation, add 1 hr to travel time

Registration


- Student Registration begins at 8:15 am

Logistics



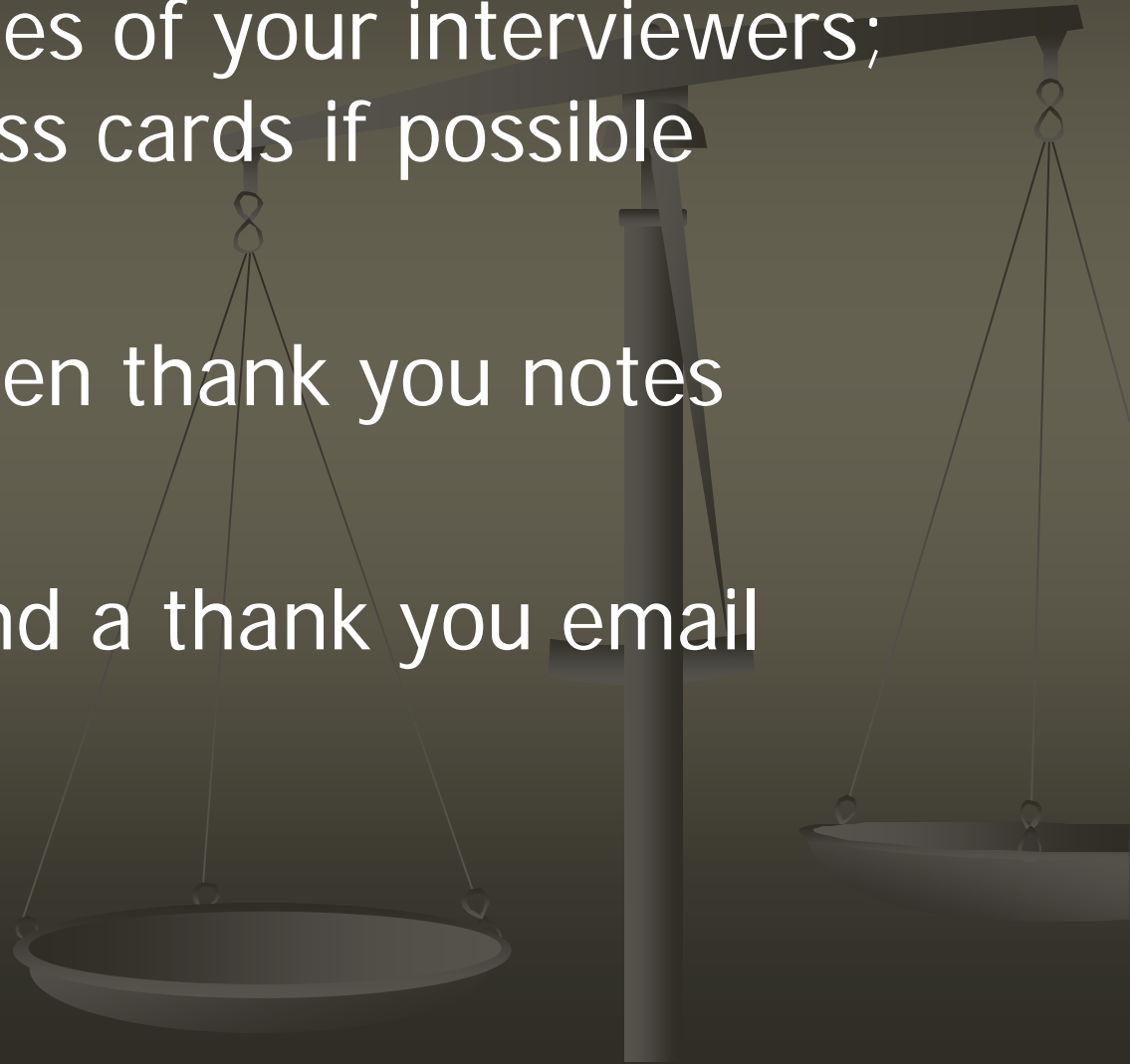
- Formal interviews at 198 McAllister Street.
- Register, get interview schedule.
- Need to sign in for Meet The Advocates
- Volunteers are there to assist you:

 - Concerns/issues
