

# **Santa Clara Law Summer study abroad Sydney and Perth, Australia (2008)**

## **Lodging**

All students will be expected to reside for the first week in Sydney (during the Australian Law course) in housing provided at a newly renovated hotel, adjacent to the UTS campus. A separate housing fee will be charged for this lodging.

### **Law and Technology course in Sydney**

No University housing will be provided for participants who remain in Sydney for the Law and Technology class. (University housing at UTS is unavailable as the University will be in session during our program). Students staying in Sydney can make arrangements during their first week in Sydney choosing from a wide range of inexpensive and convenient housing. For those not on a budget, there are a number of hotels ranging in price from moderate to expensive which surround Darling Harbour, all within easy walking distance of the Law School. When searching for housing, use "Darling Harbour" as an easy reference point.

As Sydney has an extensive, convenient, and reasonably priced public transit system, staying in hostels near the beach or in less expensive lodgings in the many neighborhoods is possible.

The housing fee for the first week in Sydney will be approximately \$460 per person sharing a twin bed room. Thereafter, prices will range from \$25 - 45 per night in a very nice hostel to about \$560 per week in a single bed room apartment. A shared efficiency/studio apartment would be between \$200 - 500 per person per week.

### **Perth**

Students taking International Commercial Dispute Resolution in Perth will stay in provided on-campus university housing. Fifteen single rooms have been reserved and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Five single bed rooms are arranged in a single building to form a suite. Each suit has two full bathrooms for each suit, a large common/sitting room and a complete kitchen. The cost for the three weeks of classes will be approximately \$375.
