² "Vienna at first glance" - Brief introduction to the general history of Austria and of Vienna. Walk through the southern part of the inner city, looking at the State Opera House, the Hotel Sacher, the Albertina, the Imperial palace Hofburg, the Heroes square (Heldenplatz), the museums of fine arts and natural history, the parliament, the town hall, the national theatre, the Roman excavations on St. Michaels square, the Demel pastry shop, Graben, St. Peters Church, the trinity column and finally the cathedral of St. Stephen (Stephansdom). We will talk about music, architecture, art, history and everyday life of Vienna and get to know famous Viennese symbols as Sacher Cake, Mozart, Beethoven, Vienna Boys Choir, Lipizzan horses and Spanish Riding school, Crown-Prince Rudolf, Emperor Frances Joseph, Empress Elisabeth ("Sissi"). We shall also visit the famous Hans Kelsen Institute who was at the end of his life teaching at Berkley University. We shall terminate our walk at one of the famous Vienna cafe. The purpose of this walk is not only the lesson of history, but also the occasion to meet in one of the most famous towns in the world.
