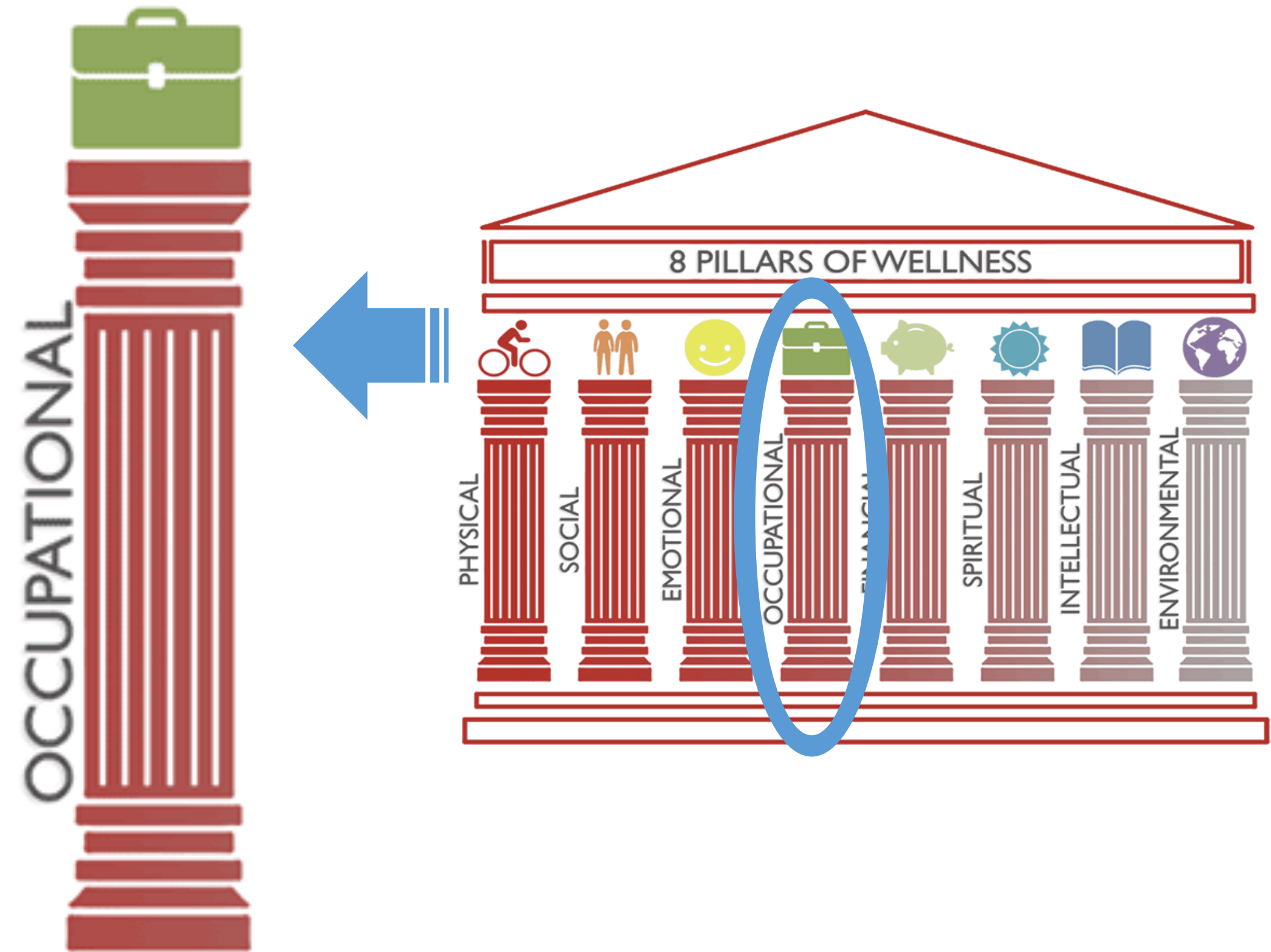
Regular physical activity, a healthy diet, and sufficient sleep are necessary to help combat the stress of law school.

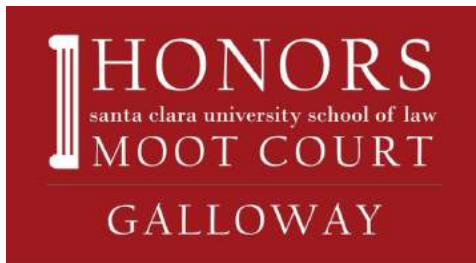
