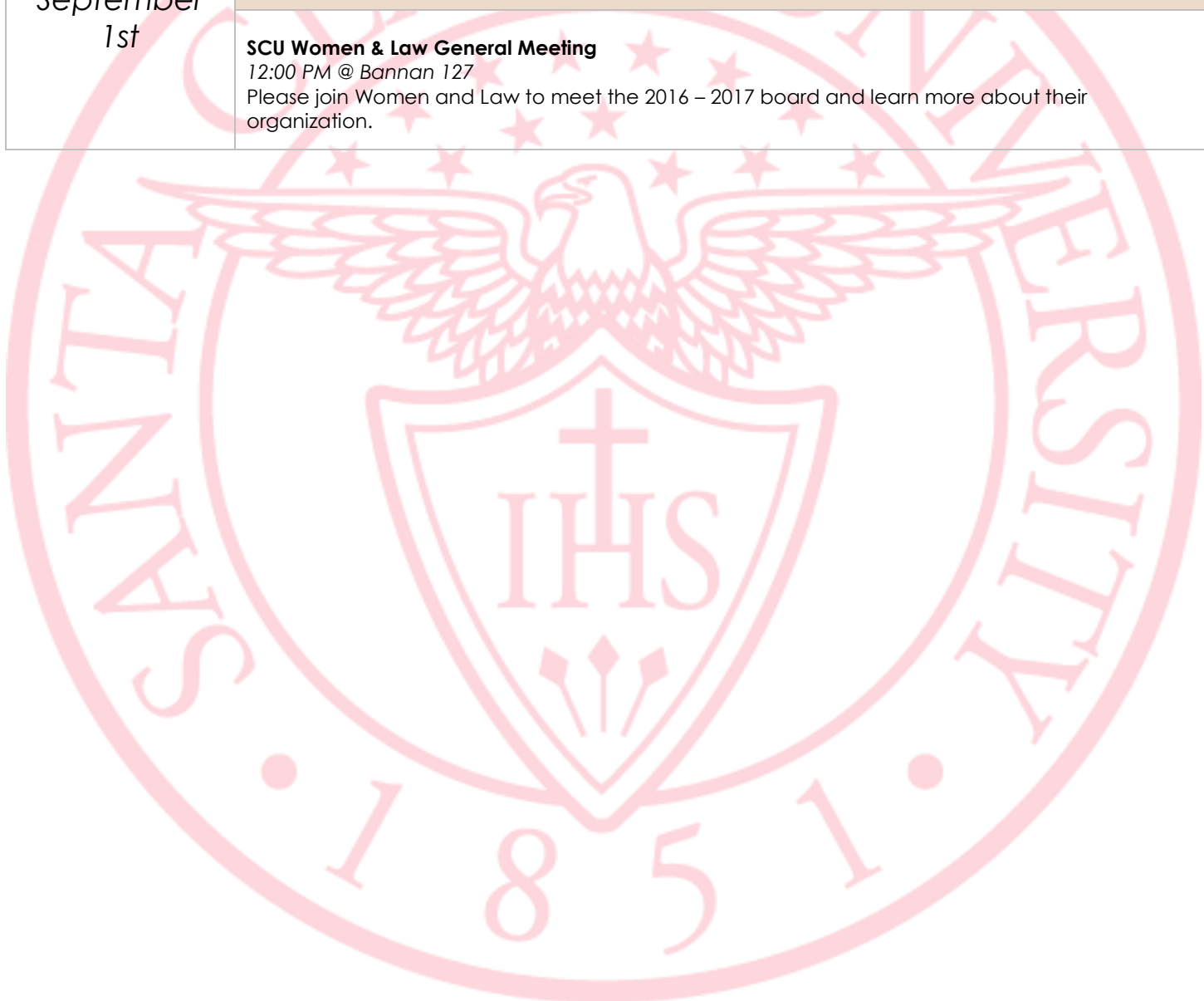

October 7th is the Exam Reschedule Request Deadline!!

Please take the time to review your exam dates and times. **October 7th** is the **LAST** day to request a reschedule for an administrative exam conflict.

Ask yourself . . .

- do I have 2 exams on the same day?

- do I have 2 exams back to back – i.e. one at 6 pm and one the next morning at 9:00 am?

If the answer to any of these questions is YES, then you have a deadline of **FRIDAY, OCTOBER 7, 2016** to request an Administrative Conflict Reschedule. You must complete the reschedule request form on-line. (emery.scu.edu/students/student-services/forms/)

Requests received after this date for Administrative Conflicts will not be approved.
