Pumpkin Pie French Toast

Ingredients

- 12 slices whole wheat sandwich bread (\$1.50)
- 3 eggs (\$.30)
- 1/2 cup milk (\$.05)
- 3/4 cup canned pumpkin (\$.75ish)
- 1 tsp pumpkin pie spice (\$.05)
- Butter and syrup for serving (\$.50)
- Fresh fruit or smoothie as side (\$1)

Directions

- Set out the bread for dipping.
- In a medium mixing bowl, whisk together the eggs, milk, pumpkin and pie spice until smooth.
- Dip each side of the bread and cook on a hot, greased griddle or skillet. Flip after 1 – 2 minutes.
- Once all are cooked, serve with butter and maple. And a side of fresh fruit.
- If freezing, let cool completely to reduce freezer burn.

Smoky Mushroom Stroganoff

Ingredients

- 18.8 ounce package dried pappardelle (wide egg noodles)
- 1 1/2 pounds sliced mushrooms, such as button, cremini, and/or shiitake
- 2 cloves garlic, minced (1 tsp.)
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 18 ounce carton light sour cream
- 2 tablespoons **all-purpose flour**
- 1 1/2 teaspoons smoked paprika
- 1 cup of vegetable broth

Directions

- Cook noodles according to package directions. Drain; keep warm.
- In extra-large [skillet cook mushrooms](#) and garlic in hot oil over medium-high heat 5 to 8 minutes or until tender, stirring occasionally. (Reduce heat if mushrooms brown quickly.) Remove with slotted spoon; cover to keep warm.
- For sauce, in bowl combine sour cream, flour, paprika, and 1/4 teaspoon pepper. Stir in broth until smooth. Add to skillet. Cook and stir until thickened and bubbly; cook and stir 1 minute more. Serve mushroom mixture and sauce over noodles. Sprinkle with parsley. Serves 4.

Tanya de la Fuente McHenry

Tanya is the Principal of de la Fuente McHenry Law, a general practice sole proprietorship representing corporate and individual clients in a variety of legal matters including IP counseling, litigation, and transactional issues. Before founding her own firm, Tanya spent eight years as Director of Litigation at SanDisk Corporation. There, she managed the Company's worldwide litigation portfolio, including patent, antitrust, securities, class actions, commercial litigation and insurance matters.

Prior to joining SanDisk, Tanya was an Associate at Cooley LLP where she focused primarily on patent litigation representing companies across a wide range of technologies, including medical devices, pharmaceuticals, and consumer products. In 2005, Tanya took leave from the firm to serve as law clerk to the Honorable James Ware (Ret.), United States District Judge for the Northern District of California.
