**For application for Social Justice Graduation Certificate
 Due Dates: November 6 (Dec. grads) and February 28 (May grads)**

Purpose of form: To qualify for a CSJ graduation certificate, applicants must complete (1) a total of 15 units of social justice coursework (16 units if applying for a certificate with emphasis in criminal justice or immigration law), (2) complete 150 hours of supervised legal work in a public interest/social justice organization, government office, or judicial externship (practicum); and (3) complete 50 hours of pro bono service. The purpose of this form is to certify the applicant's completion of the practicum requirement.

PRACTICUM: Students must complete 150 hours of supervised legal work in a public interest/social justice organization, government office, or in a judicial externship. The work can be paid, volunteer, or for unit credit. However these hours must be distinct from the 50 hours of volunteer work also required for this certificate. These hours must also be distinct from the 50 hours of volunteer work required for the Pro Bono Recognition Program. For student applying for a CSJ graduation certificate with an emphasis in criminal justice or immigration law, the practicum work should be in the area of criminal justice. NOTE: applicants may wish to submit separate forms, one for each organization for which the applicant did the practicum work.
