- 1. Percentile rankings are computed annually based upon the relevant cumulative grade point averages at the end of the spring semester. Effective Fall 2017, full-time and part-time students are ranked together. The levels are First Year (FY), Upper Division (UD) and Graduating Class (GC). The level is based on the level of completion of the juris doctor program of study.
- 2. The level of First Year (FY) is assigned to students who started their first year of law school in the fall semester of the current academic year.
- 3. The level of Upper Division (UD) is assigned to students who are not in the First Year class (FY) or the Graduating Class (GC).
- 4. The Graduating Class (GC) is assigned to students who have petitioned to graduate for the current academic year no matter how many years they have been enrolled. Class rank at the time of graduation is computed for the entire graduating class combined (December, May, and July graduates).
- 5. Students in the top 20 percent of their level, based on GPAs, are recognized on the Dean's List. Students' current and cumulative GPAs are available on eCampus.
- 6. Spring rankings are usually available late July and graduating class rankings are usually available early September.
