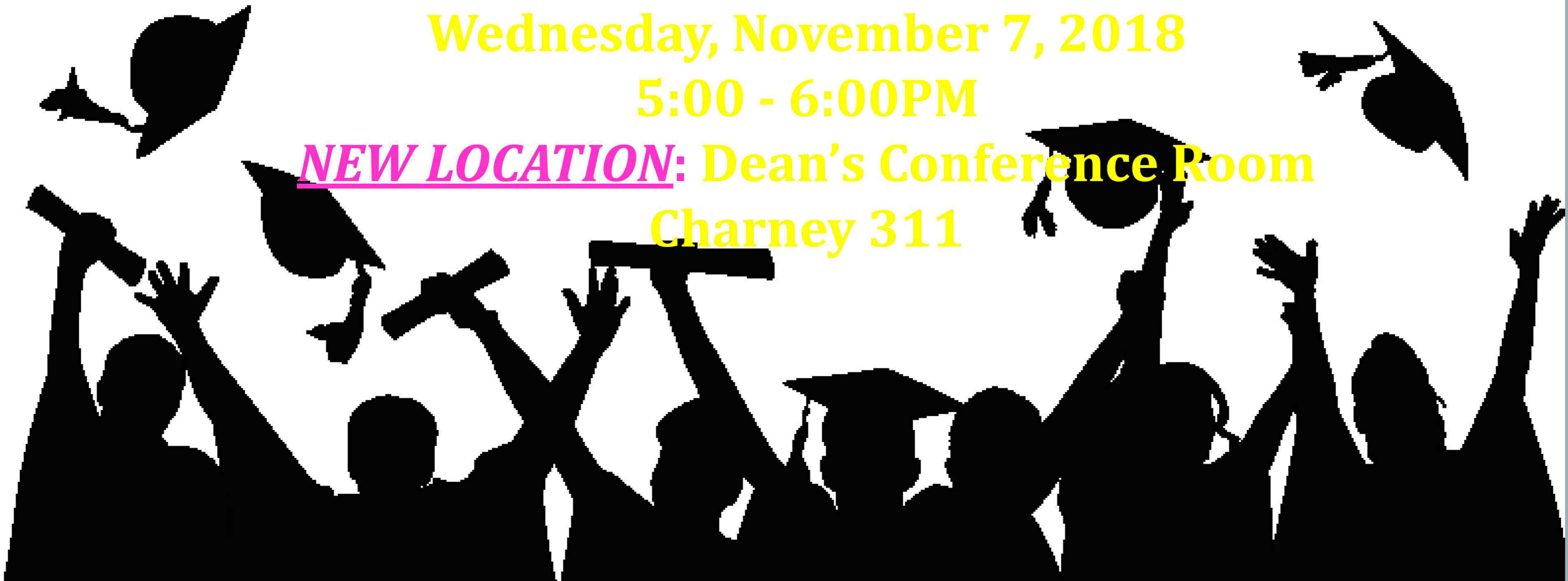

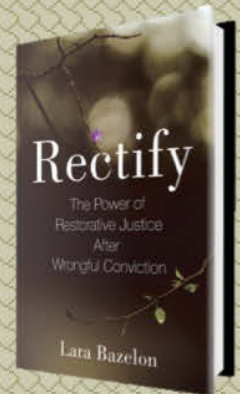




# Restorative Justice After Wrongful Conviction

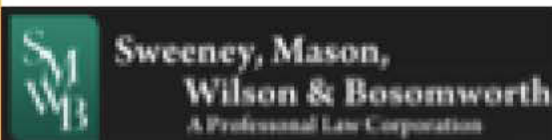

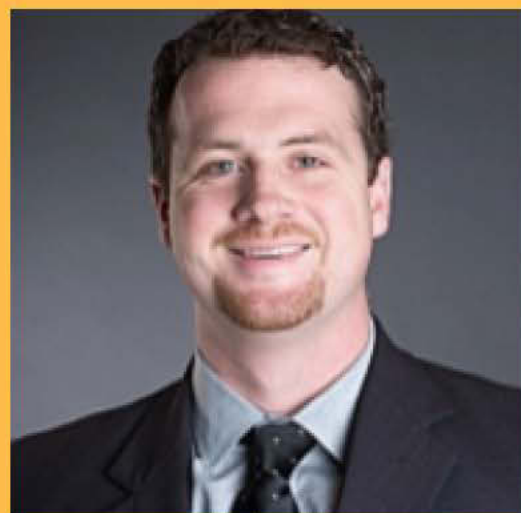
