If a class is closed during the registration period, you should add your name to the wait list, register for a back-up option, and keep an eye on your SCU email for updates!

The wait list determines the priority for enrollment as seats become available. The earlier you add your name to the wait list, the higher priority you will have. Student Services manages the wait list process (and reviews it daily) until the second week of the semester. Not until then do Professors have the ability to add students, if space permits.






