#### October 5th is the Administrative Exam Reschedule Request Deadline....

Please take the time to review your exam dates and times. **October 5** is the **LAST** day to request a reschedule for an administrative exam conflict.

Ask yourself  $\ldots$ 

do I have 2 exams on the same day?
do I have 2 exams back to back – i.e. one at 6 pm and one the next morning at 9:00 am?

If the answer to either of these questions is YES, then you have a deadline of **FRIDAY, OCTOBER 5, 2018** to request an Administrative Conflict Reschedule. You must complete the reschedule <u>request form on-</u> <u>line</u>. (http://emery.scu.edu/students/student -services/forms/)

Requests received after this date for Administrative Conflicts will not be approved.

<u>US. Law LL.M. students</u> - 10/5/18 is the last day request for a language accommodation during the examination period if applicable. To find the form, go to *http:// emery.scu.edu/students/student-services/ forms/* then search for LL.M. in U.S. Law Exam Petition for Language Accommodations.




