Ask yourself . . .

If the answer to either of these questions is YES, then you have a deadline of **FRIDAY, OCTOBER 5, 2018** to request an Administrative Conflict Reschedule. Requests received after this date for Administrative Conflicts will not be approved.

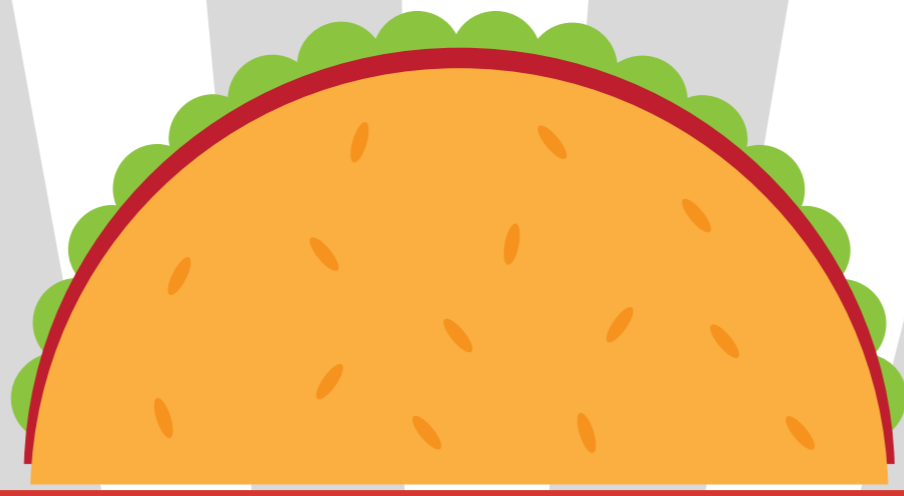

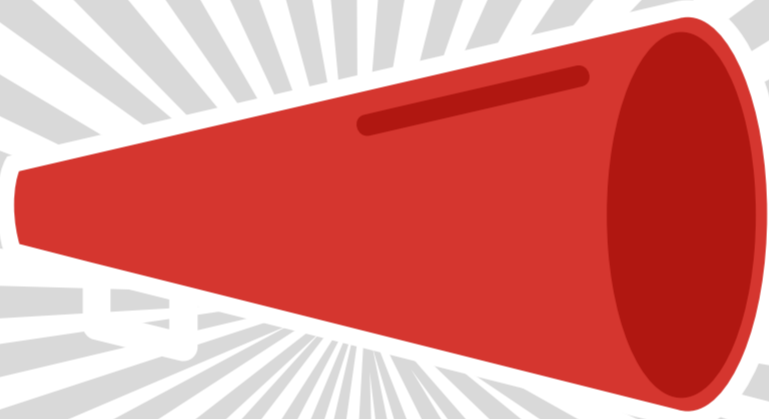

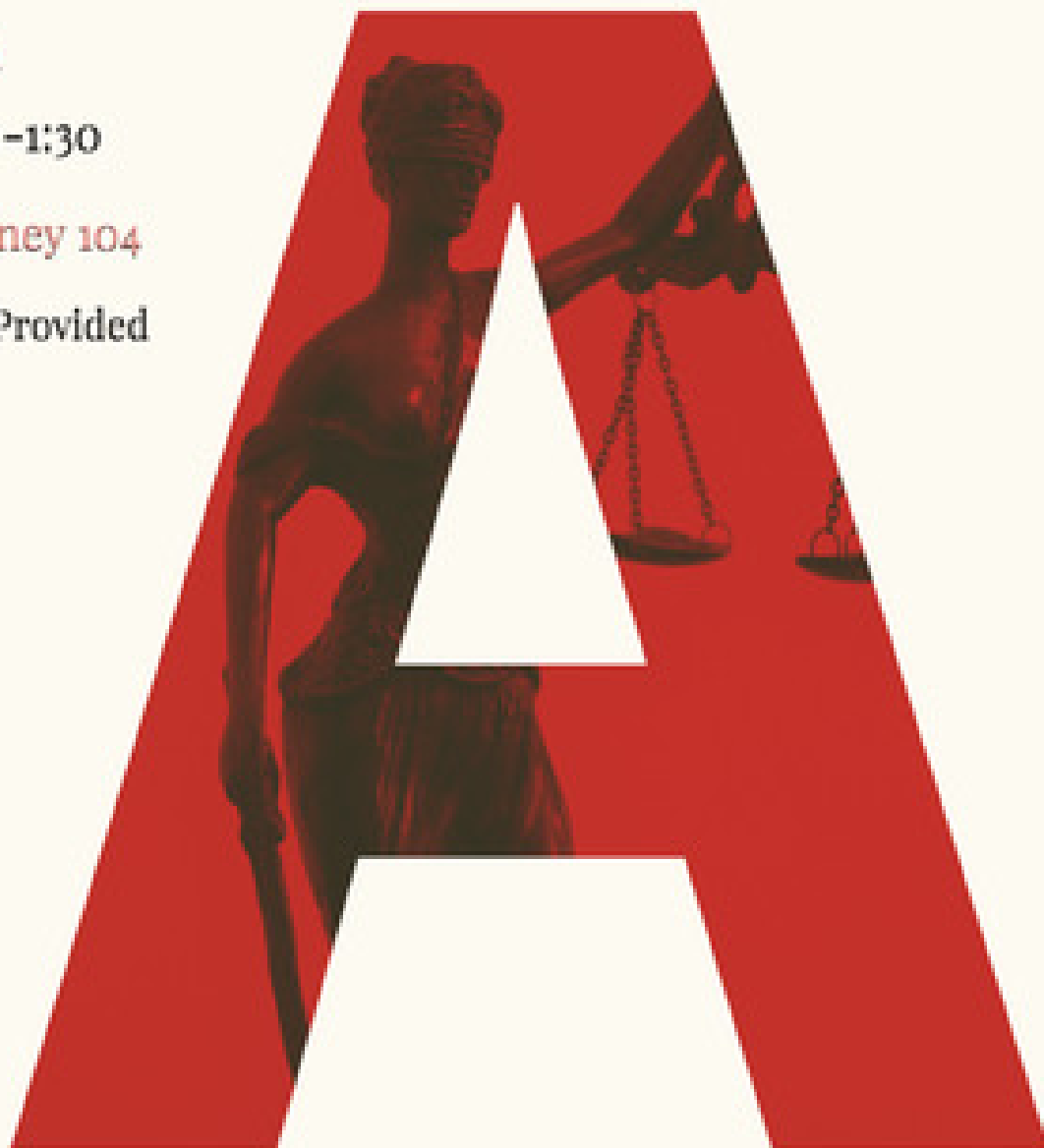
